## **Get to know Tampa Hope**



Tampa Hope was created back in March, 2020 when the City of Tampa partnered with Catholic Charities Diocese of St. Petersburg to create a temporary shelter for the homeless in Tampa. Due to the risks posed by COVID-19 as well as business closings and a reduction to food and restroom access, city officials decided to relocate residents to provide them the best opportunity for care.

The City has worked tirelessly with Catholic Charities to create permanent housing for the homeless in Tampa, and on December 13, 2021 they secured a location for such housing. Plans are in development to ultimately house 300 people while providing the services needed to return these individuals to permanent housing and self-sufficiency.

This year we want to assist in this venture of creating a safe place for those in need in our community. With the help of our Members, we are looking to raise enough funds to create a Hope Cottage. Hope Cottages will replace the tents currently being used. As we seek to lift-up each resident and provide them with a living space during their time at Tampa Hope, this will provide them with a comfortable, safe and secure place to sleep.
